Here's how it works – just instruct your supplier to ship your materials to our agent in Calais, Maine – literally just steps from the USA-Canada border. Then we take it from there. Moving it across the border, clearing it through customs, and providing delivery to your door, all with a very competitive price.

Here's how you can make it happen:

1. When issuing your purchase order instruct your supplier in the United States to ship the goods prepaid to the following address:

2. Instruct your supplier to attach a fully completed commercial and/or Canada Customs Invoice (CCI), along with a NAFTA (North America Free Trade Agreement) certificate of origin (if applicable). Both the CCI and NAFTA certificate can be found on our website www.pfcollins.com.

The Small Print:

1. Liability – the amount of loss or damage shall not exceed \$2.00/pound - \$4.40/Kg.
2. Exceptions – Perishables, hazardous, jewelry (other than costume), precious metals.
